With the addition of the NC3000 to the Network Composer product family, Cymphonix also announces the realignment of the individual product names. The Network Composer product family now includes the NC75, NC400, NC1500, and the NC3000. “This new product naming scheme will make it easier for companies to quickly identify which solution is right for them,” said Nixon. “Each product name now clearly reflects the number of users the device is capable of handling.”
